Place: Five Star Premier Residence of Reno, 3201 Plumas (North off Moana)

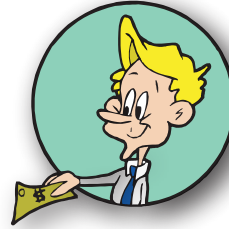
Parking is somewhat limited, so we ask that RPC members and guests park in the lot toward the back of the property.
